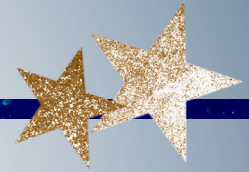

people are on the wait list for Section 8 housing vouchers.

40%

of households in the Coastal Empire are cost-burdened, spending >30% of income on housing.
